Identify and Attach Proposed Orders

You must send a proposed order to the presiding judge using your own email system. If the proposed order relates to a matter that has been referred to a magistrate judge, send the proposed order to the appropriate magistrate judge and not the district judge.

Your proposed order must be in either WordPerfect or Word format, not PDF. (Note: Judge O'Connor requires WordPerfect format.)

Type in Judge's lastname_orders@txnd.uscourts.gov as the email address (or click on the appropriate hyperlink below). You must include the Case Number and Document Number of the Related Motion in the email subject line. Do not forget to copy opposing counsel.

For example, to send a proposed order to Judge Smith in case number 3:04-cv-1234, re: document 22, "Motion to Dismiss," use the following format:
