ORDER

Before the Court are Defendant’s Motion for Clarification Regarding Date to File Motion for Summary Judgment on Indefiniteness [Docket Entry #278] and Plaintiff’s Motion to Compel Blackberry to Elect a Reasonable Number of Invalidity References [Docket Entry #275].

Defendant’s Motion for Clarification Regarding Date to File Motion for Summary Judgment on Indefiniteness is **GRANTED**. Defendant may move for summary judgment of indefiniteness, along with the issue of pre-suit damages, without prejudice to filing a subsequent motion for summary judgment. Both issues shall be raised in the same early motion for summary judgment on July 24, 2015.

Plaintiff’s Motion to Compel Blackberry to Elect a Reasonable Number of Invalidity References is **GRANTED in part**. Defendant shall identify 30 individual invalidity references in its opening expert report on August 3, 2015, without prejudice to it moving to amend upon a showing of good cause after Plaintiff serves its opening expert report.
